POSITION: CASE MANAGER – FAMILY & YOUTH SUCCESS (FAYS) PROGRAM

REPORTS TO: DIRECTOR OF FAYS

FLSA STATUS: NON-EXEMPT FULL TIME

BASIC FUNCTION:

Assesses needs and provides counseling for clients and families qualifying for FAYS program; secures emergency placement as needed. Manages, implements, and coordinates the case management. Duties include gathering information, identifying services, writing comprehensive service plans, and monitoring the delivery of services to the citizens of Deep East Texas.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The below statements are intended to describe the general nature and scope of work being performed by this position. This is not a complete listing of all responsibilities, duties and/or skills required.

- Compiles and analyzes intake and referral information to assess youth and family needs and develops a Service Plan;
- Develops a comprehensive plan of service for case management;
- Provides crisis intervention when necessary;
- provides individual, group, and family counseling to effect behavior change
- monitors and reviews Service Plan;
- visits clients in their place of residence, school and/or other community sites
- plans and prepares discharge summary;
- identifies and evaluates problems, needs, and resources relating to the development of services for the clients;
- Has contact with clients, volunteers, program specialists, local, state, and federal agencies, elected officials, private contractors, and the public.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Bachelor's degree in behavioral science, social service, or a related field, specialized and/or on-the-job training in social casework including crisis intervention, individual and group counseling; plus at least one year of relevant experience working with youth. In region travel required. Bilingual Spanish a plus.

SALARY:

\$27,000 - \$40,000 per year depending on experience, plus benefits including health insurance, retirement plan and other benefits.
